WHEREAS: Spring is upon us and summer is rapidly approaching, when a young man's fancy turns to playing basketball, baseball and congregating in neighborhoods parks; and

WHEREAS: The City Council recognizes that both the youngsters utilizing these parks as well as the neighbors who reside next to the parks have certain rights which should be respected; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Superintendent of Recreation in conjunction with the Manager and Tenant Council to develop a plan for the playground adjacent to the Francis Burns Apartments which allows for complete utilization of the park during daylight hours i.e. from 8 a.m. to 9 p.m. while providing an opportunity for the elderly residents of the Burns Apartment to enjoy the peace and serenity of their environment in the city.
