I am hereby requesting the appropriation of an additional \$4,000,000 in Safety Net funds from the Department of Public Welfare to the Health & Hospital Services Salary & Wages Account (\$500,000) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$3,500,000) to provide funds for safety net services such as the protection of low-income persons with AIDS, victims of substance abuse and addictions, trauma victims, and indigent persons without access to care who are often homeless.
