COUNCILLOR CRANE

- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to appear with the Board of Assessors at the next meeting of the City Council for the purpose of discussing the city's assessment policy for condominiums, and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Assessors to bring with them all abatements given to property owners for the years 1974, 75, 76 and 77; said abatements to include only those properties with an assessment over \$3,000 but not including abatements automatically granted by state statute such as Veteran's, elderly over 70, widows, etc., and be it further
- ORDERED: That those records include the name and address of the person or persons receiving the abatement as well as any corporation or realty trusts which may be receiving an abatement and any college or university which may fall into this category.
