- WHEREAS: The Cambridge Minority Business Enterprise Program has been successfully managed by the City Manager's Minority Business Enterprise Operating Committee since 1983; and
- WHEREAS: The City's Minority Business Enterprise Program is highly regarded by the State Office of Minority and Women's Business Assistance; and
- WHEREAS: The State Office of Minority and Women's Business Assistance has strongly recommended that the City of Cambridge establish a Women's Business Enterprise Program; and
- WHEREAS: Women's Business Enterprise Programs have already been established and are operating in other Massachusetts cities, including: Somerville, Newton, Brockton and Boston; and
- WHEREAS: It is apparent that a Women's Business Enterprise Program can be operated without harm to city's Minority Business Enterprise Program; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to evaluate Women's Business Enterprise programs in other cities, and to establish such a program in Cambridge if determined feasible; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be requested to report to the City Council the actions taken in response to this resolution.
