IN CITY COUNCIL

November 10, 1980

WHEREAS:

William Dias, a former employee of the Fire Department of the City of Cambridge, entered the service of the Fire Department on May 3, 1925 and was pensioned on August 18, 1945 under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 57 of the General Laws and died on August 20, 1980, having served not less than twenty years, and

WHEREAS:

At the time of his death said employee had no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor, his widow, Mrs. Alice Dias, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law, therefore be it

ORDERED:

That, under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 95A of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good, and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by William Dias, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Alice Dias, widow of William Dias, of \$3,000.00 per year as long as she does not remarry.

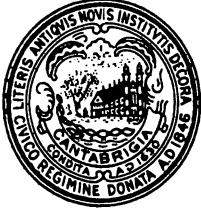


