If this is contrary to your desires, please inform this Officer and we will take immediate steps to remove Officers from certain areas and bring them forth into other areas.

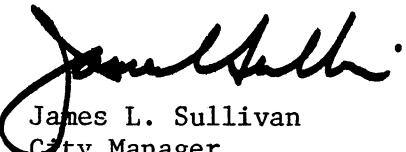
