The Supreme Court of the United and the Supreme Court of the Commonwealth have recently rendered decisions which have made it possible for law enforcement officers to more effectively combat the distribution and sale of obscene literature, and

WHEREAS:-

The Cambridge Police Department under the direction of Chief James F. Reagan were successful in securing the arrest and conviction in East Cambridge District Court of several persons who were engaged in this activity, therefore be it

ORDERED:-

That the City Council go on record congratulating Chief of Police James F. Reagan, Sgt. Anthony G. Paolillo, Detective Edward D. McNulty, Detective John J. Killion and Detective Edward L. O'Callahan for the manner in which they prepared their case and presented their evidence to the District Court and secured a great victory for law enforcement officials concerned with this problem.
