We the undersigned members of the Common Place Teen Center request that the Common Place Teen Center and the dismissal of four highly respected members of the staff be placed on the agenda of the City Council for community discussion at the earliest possible moment.

As citizens of Cambridge we request the City Council of Cambridge take immediate action to:-

- 1.) Enjoin the City of Cambridge and the Archdiocese of Boston from entering into, or signing any contract of agreement relative to the Common Place Teen Center, located at 130 Prospect Street Cambridge, Massachusetts.
- 2.) Restrain the non contracted management of Common Place from making any staff changes

We request the preceding action be taken until the following are fully resolved:-

- 1.) The reason for closing of a City funded teen center on July 7, 1980, by Father Paul Scribner of St. Mary's Church.
- 2.) The indiscriminate dismissal of four highly respected teen center staff members by Father Paul Scribner of St. Mary's Church.
- 3.) Comments by, Father Paul Scribner, that reflect upon the character of one or more of the teen center staff.
- 4.) In the absence of a signed contract agreement, what are the rights of St. Mary's Church to make any decisions in regards to City of Cambridge monies appropriated for the purpose of funding a teen center for the youth of Cambridge.
- 5.) A public record be made of all City of Cambridge monies paid and funded directly to St. Mary's Church, as well as all money paid by any City agency that involves the St. Mary's owned building at 130 Prospect Street Cambridge, Massachusetts. This includes rent, heating, utilities, teen center funding and any other programs or expenditures associated with this building.
- 6.) Whereas City of Cambridge money is used to fund this teen center, why doesn't the City manage the funds and programs directly under the recreation department?

Enclosed with this letter is a petition signed by some 500 area four youth, parents and residents in support of the dismissed teen center staff.

Enclosed also, are some letters of commendation from highly respected community leaders. These letters are not to be construed as taking side for or against anyone in this situation.

In consideration of our youth and in behalf of the teen staff, your earliest attention to this matter would be appreciated.
