To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$991,562.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$47,214.00) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$944,348). The Federal Housing and Urban Development Department has awarded the Department of Human Services Supportive Housing funds for a three-year period. Funds are received directly by the Department to act as the lead agency for the Cambridge Supportive Housing Program. The purpose of the grant is to provide supportive housing related services to people at risk of homelessness. Funds will be used to cover the cost of grant administration and to fund local agencies in supportive housing services.
