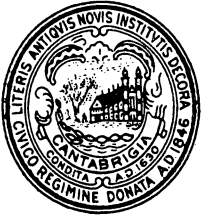

Subject : Cambridgeport Crime

As a result of the City Council hearing held at the Morse School, the Public Works Department is complying with the requests made. I have assigned:

- 1) A tree crew to the Cambridgeport area and they are trimming all trees that block street lights and shrubs that provide hiding places on public property. It would be helpful if the individuals involved in this committee would let me know if they have special locations that need attention, and we will see that the trees are trimmed.
- 2) We have placed additional trash containers in Central Square, and will continue monitoring this, particularly, with the Central Square Business Association.
- 3) The vacant lot at Hamilton and Magazine Streets is not city owned, and I have contacted the Health Department and asked them to make arrangements to have the owners clean up this lot.

Please contact me if there are any additional items that we can do in this area.
