MAYOR REEVES

WHEREAS: Cambridge residents and visitors use parking meters in Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: Users of these parking meters rely on the accuracy of the meter's measure of time; and

WHEREAS: Inaccurate measure of time can result in the unfair ticketing of the meter user; and

WHEREAS: These meters should be periodically checked so that they are accurate and fairly serve the public; and

WHEREAS: Some parking meters on Bishop Allen Drive between Essex Street and Columbia Street are inaccurate; and

WHEREAS: These faulty meters may "shortchange" its users, by giving the users only fifty minutes on the hour; and

WHEREAS: These meters need to be corrected, in order to prevent undue suffering by residents of the city; therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager, through its able Department of Traffic and Parking, check and correct the parking meters on Bishop Allen Drive between Essex and Columbia Streets.
