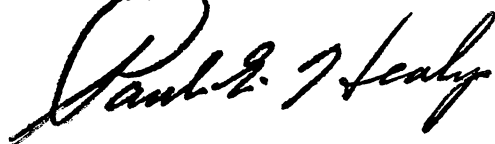

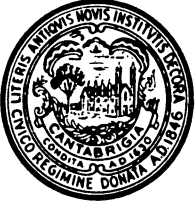

To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached please find for your review and action an order requesting the acceptance and appropriation of a grant in the amount of \$104,520 from the Massachusetts Department of Social Services to the Cambridge Hospital Grant fund. This appropriation will be distributed as follows: Salaries and Wages, \$74,020; Other Ordinary Maintenance, \$29,500; and Travel and Training, \$1,000.

This grant will provide for social work and child psychiatry staff hired and based at the Hospital to provide closed referral consultation to D.S.S. staff in Cambridge (Somerville and Arlington/Burlington areas) around specific cases of child sexual abuse. Staff will also provide direct short-term treatment services which will generate third party revenue to the hospital.

Passage of this order is recommended.
