

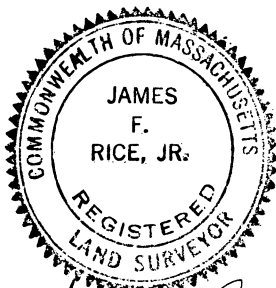

WHEREAS:

A communication has been received from James L. Sullivan, City Manager, requesting that a portion of Trowbridge Street, between Broadway and Cambridge Street be discontinued as a public way of the City of Cambridge in connection with the construction of the High School Complex; and

WHEREAS:

That due notice has been given to the owners abutting on said public way and a hearing was held before the City Council on July 7, 1976 at which time all other persons interested were given an opportunity to be heard, it is therefore

ORDERED:

That a portion of Trowbridge Street between Broadway and Cambridge Street be and hereby is discontinued as a public way of the City of Cambridge according to a plan on file in the Office of the City Engineer of the City of Cambridge entitled: "Discontinuance of a Part of Trowbridge Street" dated December 3, 1975 drawn by James F. Rice, Jr., Land Surveyor, a copy of which is recorded herewith.

Said portion of Trowbridge Street, between Broadway and Cambridge Street to be discontinued as shown on said plan is bounded and described as follows:-

Beginning at a point at the northerly line of Broadway and westerly line of Broadway and proceed.

Northeasterly by Cambridge Public Library property along two links, a line of one hundred and fifty (150.0) feet and an arc of two hundred and sixty two and twenty-six hundredths (262.26) feet with a radius of eight hundred and twenty-four and eight hundredths (824.88,) and

Southeasterly forty (40) feet by land previously discontinued,

Southwesterly by Cambridge High and Latin School property along two links, an arc of two hundred seventy-four and ninety-eight hundredths (274.98) feet and radius of eight hundred sixty-four and eighty-eight hundredths (864.88) and a line of one hundred fifty (150.0) feet to the northerly line of Broadway, and

Northwesterly by Broadway forty (40) feet to the point of beginning, containing approximately sixteen thousand seven hundred and forty-five (16,745) square feet, more or less.

Said portion of Trowbridge Street, between Broadway and Cambridge Street to be discontinued as shown on said plan is bounded and described as follows:-

Beginning at a point at the northerly line of Broadway and westerly line of Broadway and proceed.

Northeasterly by Cambridge Public Library property along two links, a line of one hundred and fifty (150.0) feet and an arc of two hundred and sixty two and twenty-six hundredths (262.26) feet with a radius of eight hundred and twenty-four and eight hundredths (824.88,)

WHEREAS:

A communication has been received from James L. Sullivan, City Manager, requesting that a portion of Trowbridge Street, between Broadway and Cambridge Street be discontinued as a public way of the City of Cambridge in connection with the construction of the High School Complex, and

WHEREAS:

Public convenience and necessity requires that a portion of Trowbridge Street, between Broadway and Cambridge Street, be discontinued as a public way of the City of Cambridge, and that this City Council intends to adopt an order providing for said discontinuance; said portion of Trowbridge Street to be discontinued is described as follows:-

Beginning at a point at the northerly line of Broadway and westerly line of Broadway and proceed

northeasterly by Cambridge Public Library property along two links, a line of one hundred and fifty (150.0) feet and an arc of two hundred and sixty-two and twenty-six hundredths (262.26) feet with a radius of eight hundred and twenty-four and eight hundredths (824.88),

southeasterly forth (40) feet by land previously discontinued,

southwesterly by Cambridge High and Latin School property along two links, an arc of two hundred seventy-four and ninety-eight hundredths (274.98) feet and radius of eight hundred sixty-four and eighty-eight hundredths (864.88) and a line of one hundred fifty (150.0) feet to the northerly line of Broadway, and

Northwesterly by Broadway forty (40) feet to the point of beginning,

containing approximately sixteen thousand seven hundred and forty-five (16,745) square feet, more or less, and

being shown on a plan entitled: "Discontinuance of a Part of Trowbridge Street" prepared by James F. Rice, Jr., Land Surveyor, on December 3, 1975, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, and be it further

ORDERED:

That due notice be given to the owners abutting on said public way, and all other persons interested, and in the manner prescribed by law, that this City Council intends to discontinue said portion of Trowbridge Street, between Broadway and Cambridge Street, and that Wednesday, July 7, 1976 at 6:00 P. M. in the City Council Chamber, City Hall are assigned as the time and place for hearing any objections which may be made thereto.
