Gentlemen:

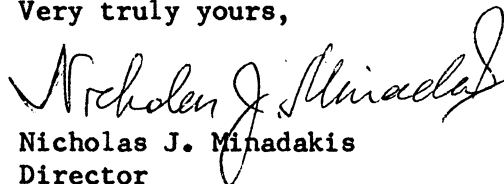
I wish to take this opportunity to add my very strong support for the construction of the J.F. Kennedy Library & Museum in the Harvard Square area of Cambridge.
