
Subject Transfer of Funds

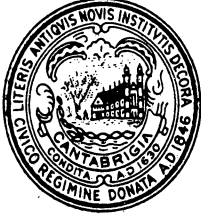


