WHEREAS: Said "private" institutions enjoy access to a public facility and most have had such privileges for more than twenty-five years; and

WHEREAS: The M.D.C. has a restriction on the term of such agreements not to exceed twenty-five years; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be instructed to draft a policy to maximize access to the river and ship facilities for the purposes of boating, instruction, and public recreation and to exact whatever cooperation from said institutions currently leasing from the M.D.C. Further, that the M.D.C. expand the City's discretion on the future use of the river and existing facilities.
