RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending congratulations to the newly elected Friends of the Cambridge Public Library; and be it further

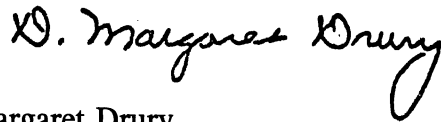
