In the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty six.

An Ordinance
Relating to the salary of the Justice
of the Police Court.

Be it ordained by the City
Council of the City of Cambridge
as follows:

From and after the first day
of April, in the year one thousand
eight hundred and fifty six, there
shall be paid to the Justice of the
Police Court of the City of Cambridge,
an annual salary of fifteen
hundred dollars, in equal quarterly
payments of three hundred and
seventy five dollars each, which shall
be in full for all services rendered
in his official capacity.
