Whereas there is heavy pressure on resident parking on Tremont Street near Cambridge Street especially during the evening hours due to the number of patrons without parking stickers using nearby restaurants;

Whereas Tremont Street residents find it difficult to park on their own street because enforcement of the resident parking program ceases in that area after 7 p.m.;

Whereas a council resolution has earlier been filed requesting that the spaces next to the DPW garage on Tremont Street be converted to resident only spaces;

Resolved that the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Traffic, Parking and Transportation Department and the Police Department to enforce systematically and consistently the resident parking area on Tremont Street during the evening hours;

Further resolved that the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Traffic, Parking and Transportation Department to expedite the posting of spaces on Tremont Street next to the DPW garage for resident parking.

Whereas observations of city designated loading zones reveal constant abuses by commercial and private vehicles;
