- 1) An update of the existing inventory of parks;
- 2) A current grading describing the current condition of each park;
- 3) Date of last capital improvement to each park;
- 4) Date of next planned capital improvement, if any, for each park;
- 5) Current maintenance plan in place for each park, including description of contracts for those parks covered by outside contractors (note name of contractor, and dates of commencement and expiration of contract); Parks maintained by the DPW should be so noted.
