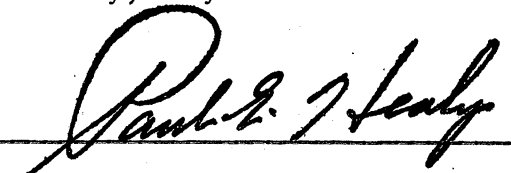
COUNCILLOR WALTER SULLIVAN

- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Thomas J. Kenney, a Cambridge native and late English Teacher at Cambridge High and Latin School; and
- WHEREAS: Tom attended local public schools, graduating from Cambridge High and Latin School in 1925 and from Colby College in 1931, where he received an undergraduate degree and in 1935 he received a master's degree from Boston College; and
- WHEREAS: During Tom's high school days, he was an avid swimmer, and in 1925 became the 50-yard freestyle interscholastic swimming champion and New England AAU 440-yard free-style champion; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Kenney began his teaching career in 1936 at the former Cambridge High and Latin School and remained there for his entire forty year career and in 1960 he was named swimming coach for the school, and in 1977 was inducted into the Eastern Massachusetts Coaches Hall of Fame, a time when his team had been the only one to win consecutive championships from 1973 to 1975; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Helen Kenney and to the entire Kenney family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Kenney on behalf of the entire City Council.
