all filed with the Department on September 14, 1973 to become effective on October 1, 1973, by the Boston Edison Company.

The Company having filed the schedules referred to above, this Department suspended the operation and use of the rates and charges set forth therein until August 1, 1974 pending study and investigation of their propriety. The proposed rate increase would, if approved, raise additional annual revenues of approximately \$43,044,000.

The Department, having completed its preliminary investigation, will hold a public hearing as to the propriety of the proposed rates and charges at its hearing-room, #1210 Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts, on Monday, February 4, 1974, at 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon.
