June 30, 1931

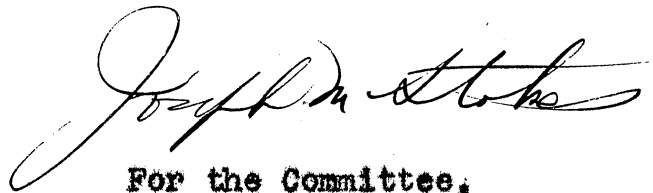
