WHEREAS: Alexander Tasonis built the home here at 333 Columbia street; and

WHEREAS: The Tasonis family has had a big military history with eight of its members serving in the Armed Forces, with two of them retiring from the U.S. Navy; and

WHEREAS: The Tasonis family has had four members working for the City at one time or another: two Firefighters, one in the License Commission, and one in the School Department; and

WHEREAS: This wonderful family has dedicated themselves to the City for over ninety years and continues to add to the quality of life here in Cambridge; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record dedicating the corner of Columbia Street and Lincoln Street as TASONIS SQUARE and further proclaim Sunday, October 26, 2003 as Tasonis Family Day in the City of Cambridge; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution for presentation to the Tasonis family on behalf of the entire City Council.

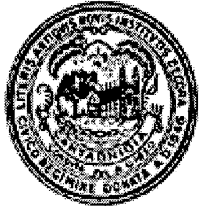
