Dear Mr. Connarton:

Mayor Sullivan has agreed to proclaim November 17th through November 27th as "Hunger Awareness Week" for the City of Cambridge. During that time, the Cambridge Food Pantry Network will be conducting its second annual city-wide food drive. The food drive will take place at local churches, public elementary schools, corporations and institutions in Cambridge.

All the donations we receive will benefit the ten operating food pantries in Cambridge. Between us, we are able to serve emergency food baskets to approximately 600 low-income households each month. In the last year, we have assisted in the creation of three new pantries and have witnessed a 100% increase in requests for emergency food assistance: an increase that has made our needs for donated foods even more critical.

Last Thanksgiving, we placed food collection boxes at City Hall and the two annexes for the duration of the food drive. Mr. David Noonan of the Mayor's office has recommended that I request formal approval from you for our proposal to place collection boxes at similar locations this year. Boxes placed at these sites enable both City of Cambridge employees and the public at large to donate at their convenience.

I am hoping that a decision on this proposal can be made in early September, so that we can continue our planning and coordination efforts in order to make this year's drive as successful and fruitful as last year's. Consequently, I would appreciate notification of your decision as soon as possible.

On behalf of all the members of the Cambridge Food Pantry Network, I thank you.
