- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of William H. McGinnis on December 12, 1982 at the age of seventy-five years; and
- WHEREAS: William H. McGinnis was born on February 23, 1907 and was a life-long Cantabrigian and dedicated public servant, who served his City faithfully and with great dedication from July 13, 1922 to February 28, 1977, where his many talents were recognized through the years, in such diverse positions as City Engineer, Assessor, Purchasing Agent and most recently, in his capacity as Superintendent of the Cambridge Water Department; and
- WHEREAS: William H. McGinnis was a graduate of Rindge Technical School and was a keen student, as evidenced by his continued studies at the Lowell Institute of Technology, Massachusetts Institute of Technology and Northeastern University in his quest to improve his base of knowledge; and
- WHEREAS: William McGinnis was active in his community for many years, taking a keen interest in politics and civic affairs and was a past President of the Cambridge Municipal Employees Credit Union, member of the Rindge Tech Alumni, New England Water Works Association and served as Chairman of the New England Section of the American Water Works Association and was the recipient of many awards through the years, including the "Man of the Year" award from the Rindge Tech Alumni, the George Warren Fuller "Water Works Man of the Year" award and in later years was associated with the Boston firm of Camp, Dresser and McKee; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Anne McGinnis and her daughters Carolyn Root and Joan E. Campbell and sons William, David, Robert and John McGinnis at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. McGinnis on behalf of the entire City Council.
