- WHEREAS: The MDC has jurisdiction over the land abutting the Fresh Pond reservation along the parkway; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager ask the MDC to look at the present classification of that land to determine whether proposed roadway improvements are legal and report back to this City Council as soon as possible.
