To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$112,725 in the Grant Fund of the Community Development Department Salary and Wages Account. Funds are from program income generated over the past few years resulting from early repayment of Lead Safe Cambridge (LSC) loans from participating property owners. Most repayment cases result from property sales where the new owner does not wish to take on the existing owner's commitment. LSC is a program designed to prevent lead poisoning, as well as create and maintain affordable lead-safe housing for low and very low- income families with young children. Funds will be used for program staff support and will assist us in extending program services through October 2002.
