WHEREAS:

Trucks, trailer trucks, buses and other commercial vehicles are causing sleepless nights, gas odors, pollution and constitute a continuing public nuisance which is detrimental to the human nervous system and threatens the well being of residents of Western Avenue, River Street, Prospect Street and Concord Avenue.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to take the necessary action to prohibit heavy trucking on Western Avenue, River Street, Prospect Street and Concord Avenue on a twenty-four hour basis effective immediately, and to further provide for alternative truck routes for these vehicles which have endangered the well being and lives of our citizens.
