

Chapter 22.

THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-two

AN ACT REMOVING THE LIMITATION ON THE MAXIMUM COMPENSATION PAID TO THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter five hundred and sixty-eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-eight is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section one hundred and three of chapter forty-three of the General Laws, the city council of the city of Cambridge may establish by ordinance the compensation to be paid to the city manager of said city.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
