American Operator Services, Inc. has filed a tariff of rates and charges relating to alternative operator services.

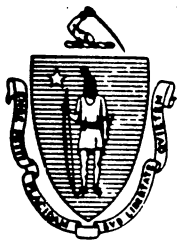

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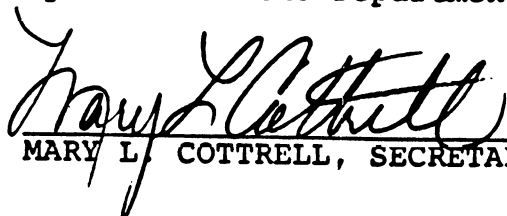
