IN CITY COUNCIL  
October 27, 1975

WHEREAS:

Stephen P. Coleman, a former employee of the Public Works Department of the City of Cambridge, entered the service of the Public Works Department on April 12, 1947 and was pensioned on May 11, 1957 under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 7, of the General Laws and died on August 2, 1975, having served not less than ten years, and

WHEREAS:

At the time of his death said employee had no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor, his widow, Mrs. Alice Coleman, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law, therefore be it

ORDERED:

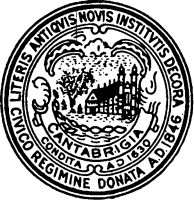
That, under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 101 of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good, and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by Stephen P. Coleman, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Alice Coleman, widow of Stephen P. Coleman, of \$1,680.00 per year as long as she does not remarry.
