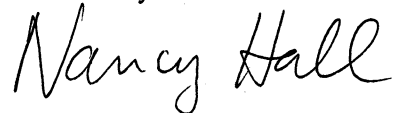
Dear City Councilors:

- 6 Porter Rd., where a large owner is evicting long term residents
- 1610-1622 Mass. Ave., where former protected status tenants are getting 60-80% increases
- other buildings being converted to condos where the state condo law is not effective

As you know, we continue to defend people's homes as best we can. There has been some good news, such as the likely sale of buildings such as 138-140 Spring St. as permanently affordable housing.
