- WHEREAS: Lieutenant Cauchon was transferred to Engine Company #4 on October 21, 1973 and to Ladder Company #4 on January 27, 1974, the assignment from which he will retire; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere gratitude to Lieutenant Robert U. Cauchon for his dedicated service and to further extend its every good wish for much good health and happiness; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to him on behalf of the entire City Council.

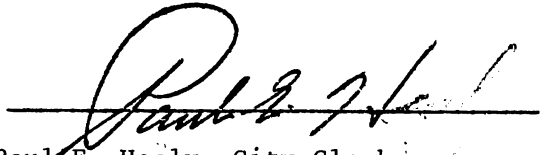
