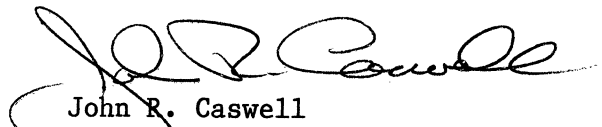
Gentlepersons:
