That notice be sent to John K. Astor, owner of a wooden building situated at the southerly corner of Brookline and Green Streets, that said building encroaches upon the south-westerly line of Green Street, and that the platform in front of the building encroaches upon the south-westerly line of Brookline Street, and directing him to remove such encroachments within seven days from this date, in default thereof the Superintendent of Streets, is hereby directed without further notice to said owner, to cause said encroachments to be removed so that said building shall conform to the lines of Brookline and Green Streets respectively.
