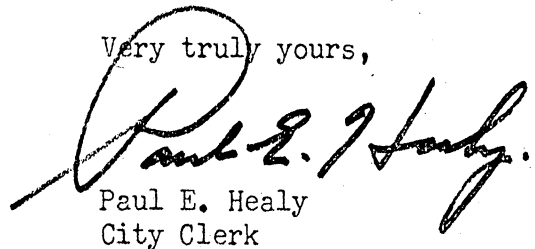
Dear Mr. McCarthy:
