WHEREAS: A petition to designate this important and unique building a landmark is currently pending at the Cambridge Historical Commission; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Council go on record in strong opposition to this devastatingly inappropriate and insensitive proposal and that this opposition be conveyed to the potential developer as well as to the Swendenborg School (not to be confused with the congregation) which has initiated the sale to the developer.
