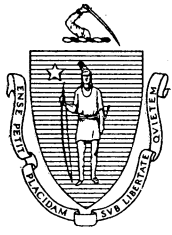
To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT

RELATIVE TO THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE ORDINANCE
ENTITLED "DOMESTIC PARTNERSHIPS" LOCATED AT
CHAPTER 2.119 OF THE CAMBRIDGE MUNICIPAL CODE AND
CONSISTENT WITH THE DEFINITIONS ARTICULATED
THEREIN, AS TO SUBSECTION 2.119.070 CAPTIONED
"EMPLOYMENT BENEFITS".

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the
authority of the same, as follows:*

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the city of Cambridge is authorized to provide group health insurance benefits to domestic partners of city of Cambridge employees and the dependents of said domestic partners.
