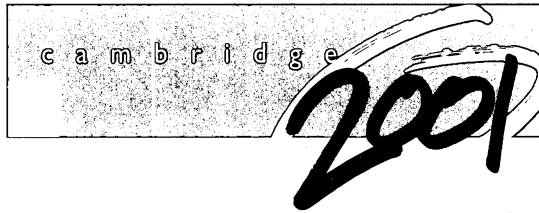

I am hereby requesting a transfer of \$875.00 in the General Fund from the Women's Commission Travel and Training Account to the Other Ordinary Maintenance Account. The Women's Commission is developing a database of Cambridge women's history, the research of which will contribute to the development of a permanent public art piece depicting women who have contributed to the history of the city of Cambridge.
