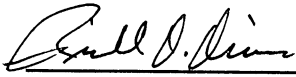
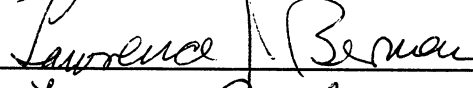
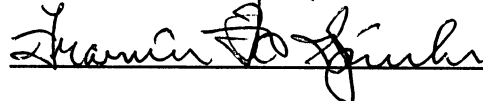

Chapter 8.16 NOISE CONTROL

Section 8.16.020 Declaration of findings and policy--Scope.

A. Declaration of Findings and Policy. Whereas excessive sound and vibration are a serious hazard to the public health and welfare, safety, and the quality of life; and whereas the people have a right to and should be ensured an environment free from excessive sound and vibration that may jeopardize their health or welfare or safety or degrade the quality of life; now, therefore, it is the policy of the City to prevent excessive sound and vibration which may jeopardize the health and welfare or safety of its citizens or degrade the quality of life.

B. Scope. This chapter shall apply to the control of all sound and vibration originating within the limits of the City, unless otherwise exempted by law. (Ord. 1121 (part), 1991)

Chapter 8.16 NOISE CONTROL

Section 8.16.050 General prohibition of noise disturbances.

No person or persons owning, leasing or controlling the operation of any source or sources of noise shall wilfully, negligently, or through failure to provide necessary equipment or facilities or to take necessary precautions, permit the establishment or continuation of a condition of noise disturbance. (Ord. 1121 (part), 1991)

Chapter 9.08 OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC PEACE AND DECENCY

Section 9.08.010 Disorderly conduct--Profanity and insulting language.

No person shall behave himself in a rude or disorderly manner, or use any indecent, profane or insulting language in any street or public place. No person shall make or cause to be made, any unnecessary noise or noises in any public street, private way or park, so as to cause any inconvenience or discomfort for the inhabitants of the City. (Prior code § 13-5)

To the Honorable, The City Council:

I write to formally complain and ask for your help regarding the issue of skateboarding noise that occurs in my neighborhood. I am aware that in September of 2002, the City Council had an agenda item concerning the construction of a skateboarding park. In response, funds were allocated to build such a park. While I am in favor of the idea, I must highlight that such a park will most likely not solve the current noise problem that occurs in my neighborhood. I ask that in addition to serving the needs of those who enjoy skateboarding that you also serve my need and right to peaceful use enjoyment of my property.

My dwelling is at the back of 20 Ware Street. The living room windows face CRLS/Broadway and all the other rooms have windows that face the alleyway. It is unfortunate that the sound that issues from skateboarding reverberates through the alleyway and therefore is heard very distinctly from my bedroom, in addition to all other rooms of my apartment.

The crashing/cracking-down and grinding sounds that this sport causes are quite disturbing. During the day, the intermittent sound repeatedly breaks my concentration. When I entertain friends, the noise often distracts us from normal conversation. The problem is heightened at night. Last summer, I was awakened by these sounds on the average of four nights a week, at times that ranged from 10:30 p.m. to 2:30 a.m. (I go to sleep at 10 p.m.) During the summer my ability to sleep has often been contingent on when the skateboarders decide to leave rather than when the police show up. I am also aware that other people in my building and in the neighborhood experience the same disturbances.

As you may already know, knowledge that CRLS is a prime skating area has been communicated by word of mouth, internet message boards and even a local skate shop bulletin board. The result has been a severe increase in the amount of skaters that frequent the CRLS property. By my neighbors' and my own estimation (and from reports of police officers), most are youth that are traveling from outside the city.

The main way I have sought to remedy the situation has been to phone the police. I am enclosing a copy of the City's Dispatch Incident Listing that reflects just some of the calls my neighbors and I have made during most of 2002. (I was told that multiple calls for the same noise problem are not always logged.)

While I am grateful to many Cambridge police officers for the control measures they have been able to exert, it seems the problem remains -- perhaps different skaters show up after the police have just cleared the area, or others come back again. At present, there doesn't seem to be a coherent policy that all the police who respond to these calls subscribe to and put into practice.

I feel strongly that if the police were able to respond in a consistently proactive manner, throngs of out-of-town skateboarders would cease traveling to CRLS to skate. In the same way that word of mouth and the internet have advertised CRLS to be a great place to skate, they can also communicate the very opposite -- that it is no longer desirable -- due to City enforcement. Please know that I would rather the police devote their energy to public safety and crime issues, but believe that vigorous policing that includes punishment in the form of a citation (similar to what Boston and Wakefield have instituted) could swiftly solve this problem and allow the police to focus on more critical issues.

I consider this to be a quality of life issue. As such, I have circulated a petition in my neighborhood, which I enclose with this letter. We are asking that the City of Cambridge take action to resolve this problem.

In addition, I am enclosing copies of three City Ordinances that are violated by allowing skateboarding activity to continue at CRLS/Joan Lorentz Park.

Beyond my personal concern of noise, I also want to highlight other ways that this affects the city:

- Liability -- Recently, a skateboarder sustained a head injury from skating on the Baldwin School property. Outside of the City, there are many horror stories of skateboarders who have been seriously injured while skating in areas not suited to the activity. One could argue that a city that allows open skateboarding in such areas could be considered negligent for not providing a proper facility.

- Infrastructure damage – The destruction being done to the CRLS property as a result of this sport is obvious to anyone who looks closely. This includes wax on concrete curbs.

Summer is not far away, and I am anxious thinking about this problem. I am curious to know what your thoughts are on this subject and would welcome the chance to speak to any members of the Council. Thank you in advance for your attention to this issue.
