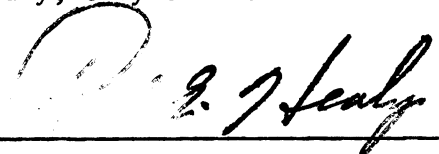
June 3, 1985
