An Ordinance

In addition to "An Ordinance establishing a System of Accountability in the Expenditures of the City."

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:— 1. There shall be appointed, at the commencement of each municipal year, a Committee on Finance, consisting of the Mayor and one Alderman, the President and five members of the Common Council, which committee shall negotiate all loans to the <sup>city</sup>, which shall be authorized by the City Council, and shall report the amount to the City Treasurer.

2. The twelfth section of "An Ordinance Establishing a System of Accountability in the Expenditures of the City," passed on the twenty fifth day of May 1846. is hereby repealed.
