

To the Honorable City Council
of Cambridge:

The undersigned respectfully petition
that a street at least sixty feet wide, may
be laid out, graded and accepted from
North Avenue to Raymond Street as follows:
Beginning on North Avenue at the Corner of
a new Street called Lambert Avenue, - thence
running westerly through land of the heirs
of Abel Whitney to the North Easterly corner of
land of John Davis Jr, - thence westerly between
the lands of said Davis, Melendy & Dexter, H. J. Melendy
and W. A. Mason on the Southern side, and
lands of said heirs of Whitney, the N. E. Brick
Company and A. Willard on Northern side, to
Raymond Street at a point near the house
of W. A. Mason and on a straight line
between said termini as nearly as may
be deemed practicable.
