To the Honorable Mayor, and Council of the
City of Cambridge
Gentlemen

The undersigned respectfully
gives notice, that, he is about to erect a new fence
in front of his land, on the northerly side of Broadway,
between Maple Avenue & land of the late E. M. Dunbar,
that the City Engineer, has given him what he claims
to be the true line of said Street, (Broadway), the
same being about one foot back from the fence, as it
now stands: that he intends to erect the new fence,
upon the line so indicated, but without prejudice
to his right, to all the land, enclosed by the present
fence, and without any intention of dedicating the
same to the City of Cambridge, or abandoning the
same,
