That the Committee contracted with Philip Kearns to do said work at the rate of Three Dollars per square.

The Contract is herewith submitted, also the Certificate of the Surveyor, showing the number of squares of filling, viz. 935-

Said work has been completed to the satisfaction of the Committee.

The sum of \$2300 has been paid to said Kearns leaving \$505.00 now due - a Bill for that amount is presented herewith, and is approved by the Committee.
