- WHEREAS: Dr. Franklin is the James B. Duke Professor Emeritus of History at Duke University; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Franklin has been active in numerous professional and education organizations, including the Journal of Negro History, The American Studies Association, the Southern Historical Association and has been a member of the Board of Trustees of Fisk University, the Chicago Public Library, and the Chicago Symphony Orchestra Association; and
- WHEREAS: Currently, Dr. Franklin serves as chairman of the advisory board for One America: The President's Initiative on Race; and
- WHEREAS: In 1996, Dr. Franklin was elected to the Oklahoma Historians Hall of Fame and in 1997, he received the Peggy V. Helmerich Distinguished Author Award; and
- WHEREAS: In addition to his many awards, Dr. Franklin has received honorary degrees from more than one hundred colleges and universities; now therefore be it
