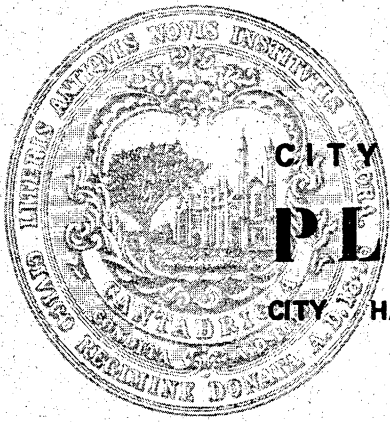

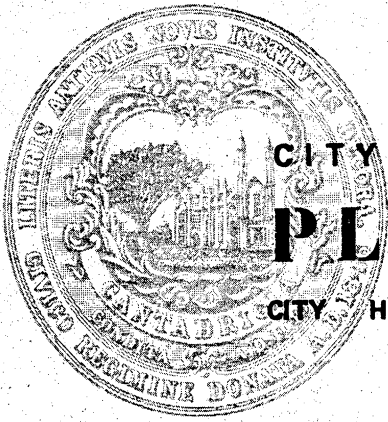

Sale of two houses in the Water Department Reservations at Weston and Lincoln, Massachusetts.

1. The house in Weston: one gate-house. It is a two-story wooden frame structure of 20 X 22 feet, with an attached barn of 16 X 20 feet, resting on a balanced stone foundation.
2. The house in Lincoln: is located on Trapelo Road, Lincoln. It is a two-story wooden frame structure 30 X 34 feet, with an unattached barn 22 X 30 feet, resting also on a balanced stone constructed foundation.

There was no legal sub-division of the lots as such, due to the fact that the two houses were placed on large farms that were acquired by the Water Department when the reservation was set up.

No deeds had been recorded relative to the property since 1895, the date of construction of the property in question. The houses are presently occupied by Joe Libbitz in Weston and Henry Manuel in Lincoln, Mass.
