WHEREAS:

There currently exists a serious parking shortage in the vicinity of the Middlesex County Courthouse, and,

WHEREAS:

This shortage will further be amplified when construction of the new firestation begins and forces the closure of the parking lot presently occupying the site, and

WHEREAS:

Discussions by the Middlesex County with the Museum of Science concerning possible temporary daytime use of a portion of their parking lot have thus far proved futile, and

WHEREAS:

There are acres of vacant and unused land in Kendall Square which could serve temporarily as a parking lot, with an appropriate, county financed shuttle service to the Courthouse, now therefore be it

ORDERED:

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct Mr. George Teso and Chief Fratto confer with representatives of Middlesex County about the feasibility of this proposal.
