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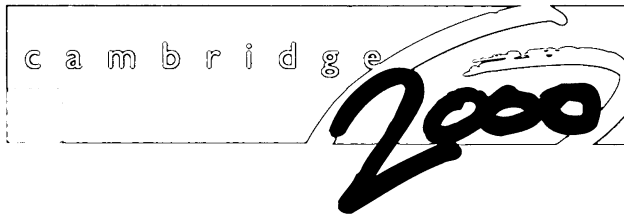

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$364,705 in the Grant Fund of the Human Services Salary and Wages Account \$(9,985), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$353,470), and Travel and Training Account (\$1,250).
